Compounds having the structure $R_2NN:$ \leftrightarrow $R_2N^+=N^-$. These compounds can also be called diazanylidene or hydrazinylidene. They have also been called by the trivial name azamines and the incorrectly formed name 1,1-diazene. They should not be called aminonitrene.
