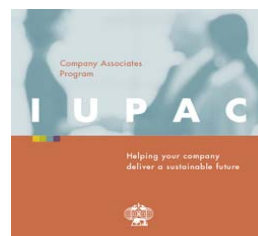

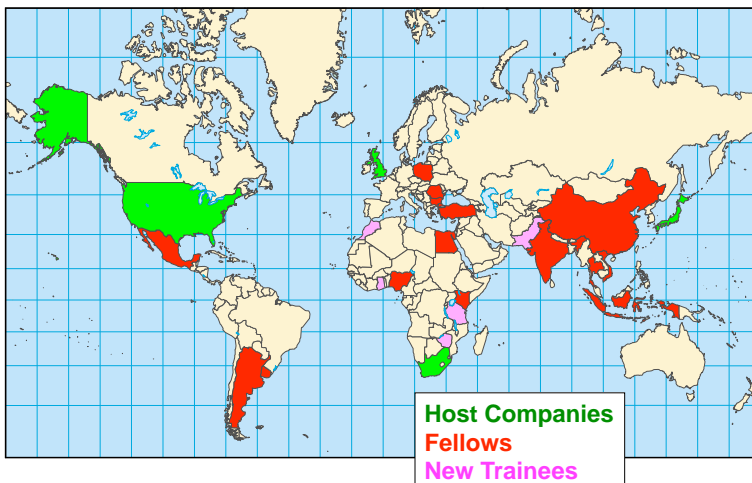
The Safety Training Program
